

Position: **Worship Leader at LifePoint Community Church**

Supervisor: Senior Pastor

Salary: Varied based on experience. Starting at \$900 per month minimum

Position Description:

This is a part-time (20 hours per week), salaried, professional position reporting to the Senior Pastor. In collaboration with the Senior Pastor, you will organize and develop the weekly worship and music program for the congregation including contemporary arrangements of traditional hymns, praise and worship choruses, and songs. Scripture readings and prayerful contemplation guided by the Holy Spirit will aid in preparing a Christ-centered worship experience for the congregation. You may have opportunities to expand the worship/music ministry into other areas including creative arts, multimedia, and contemporary forms of worship as directed by the Senior Pastor. This is truly a unique opportunity for the right candidate.

The Worship/Music Leader Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with Senior Pastor, church staff, and vocalists/musicians to organize and develop a weekly Christ-centered worship/music service including (but not limited to) selection, arrangement, musical offerings, and Scripture readings for the service. In addition, plan and coordinate other Worship/music services (weddings, funerals, special services, creative arts programs, etc.) as needed or as directed by the Senior Pastor. Other responsibilities include:
- Organize scheduled rehearsals with all vocalists, musicians, staff, and volunteers taking part in the worship/music ministry.
- Lead the worship/music service - Using your skills as a vocalist and musician to help bring others closer to Christ.
- Recruit and lead other team members including paid and volunteer musicians, vocalists, audio/video staff, and staff.
- Support and develop vocalists/musicians of all experience levels to use their God-given talents to worship and praise Jesus Christ.
- Collaborate closely with the Senior Pastor, church staff, and other church volunteers to develop worship/music programs for children and youth as needed.
- Supervise all persons taking part in the worship/music ministry to disciple and encourage them to have a closer relationship with Christ and other church members.
- Administer the worship/music ministry budget, church music license, music library/resources, and personnel.

Training and Experience:

The Worship/Music Leader should have basic vocal and/or instrumental talent sufficient to lead a musical ensemble of other vocalists and instrumentalists.

Prior experience with using Church Planner and leading Sunday Worship preferred but not required.

Other Necessary Gifts and Graces:

- Have made a public profession of faith including baptism and have a growing relationship in Jesus Christ.
- Demonstrate Christian integrity and character in all public and private affairs, including relationships with those participating in worship/music ministry, church leadership, and others.
- Maintain consistent and growing time in prayer and Bible study.
- Demonstrate a strong desire to see the Gospel proclaimed in word and deed to all people.
- Submit to the authority of God's Word, and the leadership of LifePoint Church in all matters.
- Work closely with other music ministries of the organizations to whom LifePoint Church is affiliated.
- Support the ministries of LifePoint Church with time, talents, and treasures.
